



ATTENTION SOCIAL WORKERS

If your current social work license was first issued to you in 2009 or after, you are subject to the new six hour social worker safety awareness training requirement.

In April, Governor Parkinson signed into law a requirement that, beginning in 2011, all social workers who are renewing any level of license, for the first time, must have six hours of social worker safety awareness training. The six hours is part of the already required 40 hours of CE necessary for social work licensure renewal. The licenses include the LBSW, LMSW, or LCSW.

If you do not have the training completed by the time you are renewing your social work license, you risk losing your license.

Don't let this happen to you. Plan now and get this training done.

The Kansas Chapter, NASW has scheduled four trainings that will meet this requirement.
